

HVGO STAGE PLOT 2015

Large-hall HVGO stage setup: to the left, the director has a mixer on a table, with the sub-mix of the 3 acoustic and 2 nylon string guitars, and one bass, fed to a stereo power amp, (or powered speakers)- there are 19 total players seated with music stands (including drummer), plus the director who stands by table, with a vocal/instrumental mic at center stage. The electric guitarists all use combo amps, (supplied by HVGO). Because of the large size of the hall (1,200+), there is a pair of inward-facing monitors, which fold the acoustic instruments and single bass back to the orchestra, there was also an identical pair facing the audience just outside the picture. In all but the largest halls, a pair of powered speakers set at the sides tilted 30° inward will function as FOH and monitors for the players. 4 Power strips are connected to separate outlets in this picture, more than adequate power for the HVGO.

*Drummer requires no mic'ing... set up on a 10' x 10' rug. MUST have bass cab close to drum throne.
